Introduction to Nineteenth Century Collections Online (NCCO) and Archives Unbound

[The Long 19th Century: From the French Revolution (1789) to World War I (1914)]

NCCO:

- 272 Archival Collections, organized into 12 themes
 - o British Politics and Society
 - o Asia and the West: Diplomacy and Cultural Exchange
 - o Europe and Africa: Commerce, Christianity, Civilization, and Conquest
 - o <u>European Literature</u>, 1790-1840: The Corvey Collection
 - o British Theatre, Music, and Literature: High and Popular Culture
 - o Photography: The World through the Lens
 - Science, Technology and Medicine: 1780-1925, Parts I and II
 - Women: Transnational Networks
 - o Children's Literature and Childhood
 - Mapping the World: Maps and Travel Literature
 - o Religion, Society, Spirituality, and Reform
- 5 Main content types:
 - Maps
 - Monographs
 - Manuscripts
 - Newspapers
 - Photographs

Browsing and Searching (Swimming and Diving)

Browse Individual Collections

- Use the Explore Collections tab at the top of the screen to see all 272 collections
- Limit by using the facet options at the left of the screen
- Browse the available maps using the Maps Locator. There are many Canadian and NB maps available. Use the zoom and expand features to see more clearly.

Activity 1: Scroll through the Explore Collections listing, and open one or two to see what's inside.

Search One or More Collections

- Keyword or Advanced Searching
- Phrase searching: "cat and the fiddle"
- Truncation: carib* = Carib, Caribbean, caribou, etc.
- Wildcards:
 - ? = exactly one character [psych????y finds psychiatry and psychology (but not psychotherapy)]

Password: nbaccess

- ! = one or no characters [labo!r finds labor and labour]
- Proximity: labour n5 strike (the words labour and strike must be within 5 words of each other)

Working with Search Results

- Samples of each content type. Find the "View all" link to see the full list
- Use facet options at left to further limit
- Explore term clusters to identify more specific topics in your search results
- Search within the results
- Bookmark the search results as a whole, to obtain a durable URL (http://tinyurl.galegroup.com/tinyurl/VLeg9)
- Keyword in Context, Full Citation, About this Collection
- Opening the work. Notice "Relevant Pages" with your search terms
- Full screen view

Activity 2: Search for the word 'women' within 3 words of 'vote'. Open the *Subject File, 1848-1950,* under Manuscripts. Open one of the relevant pages listed on the right, and read it in full screen. Remember to expand the image size so that you can read it easily.

Creating an Account to Save Searches, Results and Annotate Entries

• Use the "Sign In" link at the top of the main page, or click on a folder icon beside any record to begin creating an account.
