

Transcript: Course Reserves at UNB Libraries

In this video, you will learn how to access your course reserves.

Course reserves are materials selected by your instructor, which have been made easily accessible to you through UNB Libraries. These include books, articles, movies, handouts, and more.

Many course reserves are available online, so you don't even have to visit a library building. Course reserve lists are available from the UNB Libraries' homepage--www.lib.unb.ca--via the Reserves tab, located above the main search box.

You can access materials on reserve for your course by searching for the course code or instructor's name. You can access all materials on reserve for all your courses by logging in with your UNB credentials. Logging in also ensures that you can access any licensed content specific to your courses.

Your reserves can also be accessed from the homepages of your course modules in D2L Brightspace. Simply select the link in the bottom-left corner to access course reserves available through the libraires.
